Meet Format: This will be a deck seeded, timed finals meet. Events are the same as those in a Lakeland Swim Conference Dual Meet. The meet will be run in accordance with the current USA Swimming technical rules, except as provided in Article 5, Section 3.C (false starts) of the Lakeland Swim Conference By-laws.

Officials: Pre-registration is required for all officials. A request for officials will be sent to each team. Each team is expected to provide officials. There will be no admission charge for officials that have pre-registered. Hospitality will be available to coaches and officials at the meet. All officials should dress in proper attire (white shirt, blue shorts/skirt/pants) and should sign in at the Admissions Table no later than 8:00 AM.

Division Dual Meet Champion Trophies: Will be awarded immediately following Butterfly events. Meet will resume after a short lunch break with Backstroke, Freestyle, and Relay events.

Entry Deadline:

Entries must be received by the league statistician no later than noon, Tuesday, August 10, 2021. Entries for swimmers initially swimming A Championship qualifying times at dual meets held on Wednesday, August 11, 2021, must be received by the league statistician no later than noon, Thursday, August 12, 2021. Additional detailed instructions relating to entries will be forwarded directly to each team's statistician by the league statistician.

Warm up Assignments: Will be determined and e-mailed to teams after all entries have been received.

Timing Assignments: Will be determined and e-mailed to teams after all entries have been received. Each team must provide timers and watches.

Awards:

**Coaches must pick up all individual and team awards promptly at the end of the meet.

Medals: 1st through 16th place in all individual and 1st through 8th in all relay events.

Trophies: The team with the most overall points will be awarded the Meet Championship trophy. Top scoring team from the other division will also receive a trophy.

Dock Access:

Only swimmers, certified coaches, certified officials, timers, and authorized meet operations personnel may enter the dock area. Parents, swimmers, coaches, and officials will enter/exit the facility at the designated entry and exit points.

Swimmer Check-in:

Swimmers should check in with their coach immediately upon arrival. Coaches will report all scratches at the scratch meeting. After the scratch meeting, final seedings will be determined and posted. Coaches and swimmers are responsible for ensuring that the swimmers get to the marshalling area in time for their respective events. If a swimmer who has not been scratched misses an event, that swimmer will be deemed a "NS" (no show) in that event but will not be disqualified from participation in any subsequent individual or relay events.

Spectators:

There will be an area designated for "team tents". Spectators may watch from the side bleachers. We ask that spectators be considerate and vacate the bleachers after viewing their swimmer(s).

Under no circumstance will spectators be allowed on deck. Please do not save seats in the spectator area. Host team volunteers will monitor the spectator area. Spectators are expected to cooperate with security and safety requests.

Inclement Weather:

The Meet Committee and the Lakeland Swim Conference Executive Board will make all decisions concerning meet cancellation.

Concession:

Breakfast and Lunch will be available throughout the meet. A complimentary lunch will be provided for all coaches and officials.

Swim Gear:

California Beach Hut will be on site with swim gear for sale during the meet.

T-Shirts:

Parking:

A limited number of parking passes will be distributed to team delegates at the August 8th adjustment meeting for parking near the main entrance to the lanes. Only cars displaying parking passes will be permitted to park in the roped off area. General parking is available on the grass along Marvin Ave/PV Park Road. Additional parking is available in the back of the PV Park parking lot. When the lot is full, parking is available on the street along Village Road and surrounding streets. Please obey local parking laws. There will be parking attendants to direct traffic.
